

## CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES

### STREETSCAPE

Phase 3 construction continues during the week of October 12.

Work on the east side of Douglas between Division Street and Symphony Way and on the north side of Symphony Way between Douglas Avenue and Dundee Avenue continues this week. Pavement restoration on Douglas Avenue between Chicago Street and Highland Avenue will be completed this week.

Curb and gutter removal, sidewalk removal and filling of abandoned sidewalk vaults on the east side of Douglas between Highland Avenue and Division Street and along the south side of Division Street between Douglas Avenue and Center Street is scheduled to begin by mid-week

On Monday, October 12, the entrance to the City parking lot at Division Street and Douglas Avenue will be closed for pavement patching. The entrance is scheduled to be re-opened by the end of the week. Access to the parking lot will be available from Dexter Court, Highland Avenue and north Grove Avenue.

Phase 3 includes Douglas Avenue between Chicago Street and Kimball Street, Division Street between Douglas Avenue and Center Street and Symphony Way between Douglas Avenue and Dundee Avenue.

### WATER MAIN

Phase 4 of the Central Business District improvements continues next week with the water main installation. Phase 4 work includes Highland Avenue from Riverside Drive to Center Street; Spring Street from Highland Avenue to Division Street and Center Street from Kimball Street to Dundee Avenue.

Because of weather related issues, the previously scheduled lane closures at Highland Avenue and Douglas Avenue (originally scheduled for Thursday night, October 8) is rescheduled to Monday night, October 12. Lane closures will begin at 7:00 p.m. Highland Avenue will maintain one lane of traffic at all times. Douglas Avenue will be closed at Highland Avenue. Southbound traffic on Douglas will be detoured west to Grove Avenue, south on Grove Avenue to Chicago Street and then east to Douglas. Northbound Grove Avenue will be detoured east on Chicago Street to Spring Street, north on Spring Street to Highland Avenue and then west on Highland Avenue back to northbound Douglas Avenue. Local access to businesses and residences on Douglas Avenue between Chicago Street and Highland Avenue will be available from Chicago Street. The lanes closures will only occur during the overnight hours and traffic should re-open by 6 a.m. on Tuesday, October 13.

Weekly progress meetings for the Central Business District construction project are held on Thursdays at 8:30 a.m. at the construction office located at 201 E. Chicago Street. Business and property owners are invited to attend the first 15 minutes of the meeting if they have any questions or concerns regarding the construction.
