

## CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES

### STREETSCAPE

Phase 3 construction continues during the week of November 9.

Pavement surface removal was completed on November 5, 2009 on Douglas Avenue, Symphony Way and Division Street. Resurfacing begins on **Wednesday, November 11**.

Structure adjustments in the new pavement will require lane closures to complete in a safe and rapid manner. On **Thursday, November 12** southbound Douglas will be closed from Kimball Street to Highland Avenue. Traffic will be detoured at Kimball Street east to Spring Street, south on Spring Street to Highland Avenue, west on Highland Avenue back to Douglas Avenue.

On **Friday, November 13**, southbound traffic will be reopened and northbound Douglas will be closed from Highland Avenue to Kimball Street. Northbound Douglas (Grove Avenue) will be detoured east bound on Chicago Street to Spring Street, north on Spring Street to Kimball Street and then west on Kimball back to Douglas Avenue eastbound. All lanes will be open to traffic by Friday, November 13.

Sidewalk removal and sidewalk vault filling will begin on the east side of Douglas Avenue between Chicago Street and Highland Avenue on Wednesday, November 11.

All cross traffic on Douglas Avenue, at Highland Avenue, Division Street, Dexter Street/Court and Symphony Way will be open. Any short term closures due to work in the proximity of each intersection will be directed by construction personnel.

Placement of the final surface course is scheduled to begin during the week of November 16, whenever weather conditions permit.

### WATER MAIN

Phase 4 of the Central Business District improvements continues next week with the water main installation. Phase 4 work includes Highland Avenue from Riverside Drive to Center Street; Spring Street from Highland Avenue to Division Street and Center Street from Kimball Street to Dundee Avenue.

Pavement restoration on Highland Avenue between Riverside Drive and Douglas Avenue begins this week in preparation for the upcoming holiday shutdown.

Weekly progress meetings for the Central Business District construction project are held on Thursdays at 8:30 a.m. at the construction office located at 201 E. Chicago Street. Business and property owners are invited to attend the first 15 minutes of the meeting if they have any questions or concerns regarding the construction.
