

# CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

## CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES

Construction work in the Central Business District continues during the week of May 25. There will be no work in the CBD over the holiday weekend. Work is scheduled to resume on Tuesday, May 26.

### Overnight Construction

Overnight work will continue on the water main connections. Most of the work will be at various intersections throughout the week. Overnight work is expected on Wednesday, 5/27, Thursday, 5/28 and Friday, 5/29. The locations where overnight work remains are 1) Douglas Ave at Chicago Street; 2) Douglas Ave at Highland Ave.; 3) Douglas Ave. at the alleyway on the north side of 111 N. Douglas; 4) Dexter Street at Douglas Ave.; 5) Spring Street at Symphony Way and 6) Spring Street at Division Street. Traffic will remain open during the work and will be flagged by construction personnel. Overnight work generally occurs between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Overnight work should conclude during the week of June 1.

**Pavement restoration** work on Douglas Avenue between Symphony Way and Kimball Street continues this week. Parking on the east side of Douglas will be prohibited to allow two lanes of traffic to be maintained around the construction. Additional pavement restoration work will follow the water main connections indicated above.

Weekly progress meetings for the water main project are held on Thursdays at 8:30 a.m. at the construction office located at 201 E. Chicago Street. Business and property owners are invited to attend the first 15 minutes of the meeting if they have any questions or concerns regarding the construction.
